Welcome to the thirtieth **Cumbria Classic Weekend** which this year takes place over the weekend of August 18/19th We are repeating our successful format with a package of two events, which we hope will encourage you to stay in the Lake District and in the beautiful district of Eden in particular.

The Rose and Thistle Tour takes place on Saturday and visits some of the most interesting roads in England and Scotland. Sunday sees the **Cumbria Classic Car Show** staged in the spectacular setting of Dalemain House by Ullswater

As well as the usual club stands, autojumble, and hundreds of cars we will have arena action, autotests, motorsport display, children's rides, a trade area, craft stalls, entertainment and toy and produce stalls.
