

WIGTON MOTOR CLUB/ GATES TYRES RALLY AWARDS 2017

Eligibility

- 1) Wigton Motor Club (WMC) will promote a closed to club challenge for historic, classic and targa cars. The number of registered crews is unlimited but entries on the rounds will be on a first come first served basis. The series is sponsored by Gates Tyres and the aim of the series is to support and encourage clubmans' rallying.
- 2) In order to score points for awards WMC members must register for the challenge using the registration form on page 3. Points will not be allocated retrospectively to competitors who register part way through the year. All cars must display current challenge decals preferably on each side just in front of the front doors.
- 3) The Challenge is open to **Pre Historic** (pre 1960); **Historic** cars (1960-1967 inclusive); **Post Historic** cars (1968-1974 inclusive), **Cat 3** cars (1975-81 inclusive), **Cat 4** cars (1982-1985 inclusive) and **Targa** cars complying with relevant requirements of the MSA Blue Book as amended, eg, Sections J and R, particularly R18 &19; and, the Supplementary Regulations issued by organisers of events selected as Rounds of the Challenge . The Categories referred to in this paragraph will be subdivided into classes by capacity at either 1400cc or 1500cc:

Cat 1.1 Pre Historic	Class F1 Up to 1500cc	Class F2 over 1500cc
Cat 1.2 Historic:	Class H1 Up to 1500cc	Class H2 over 1500cc
Cat 2 Post Historic:	Class P1 Up to 1500cc	Class P2 over 1500cc
Cat 3 Classic	Class C1 Up to 1500cc	Class C2 over 1500cc
Cat 4 Post Classic	Class D1 Up to 1400cc	Class D2 over 1400cc
Cat 5 Targa	Class T1 Up to 1400cc	Class T2 over 1400cc

NB. Cars entered under Cat 4 (Classes D1 and D2) and Cat 5 (Classes T1 and T2) will be eligible to compete for Class D and Class T awards respectively but will not be eligible for Overall awards. Classes may be merged within a category depending on the number of registrations in each class.

- 4) An eligibility scrutineer will be appointed by WMC. All major components, eg, engine, gearbox, axle must come from the car's manufacturer unless the car is a period kit car.
- 5) (i) Scoring for overall awards will be allocated on each round using a descending scale from 25 to 1 point and for class awards from 10 to 1 point. Additional awards may be presented at the organisers' discretion.
(ii) Competitors will be eligible for points from all rounds entered and competitors, marshals and organisers must claim their points within four weeks by contacting the points coordinator. If rounds are cancelled, the final results will be decided on the scores from the remaining rounds in the order 6 from 9, 6 from 8, 5 from 7, 5 from 6, 5 from 5 with the minimum number of rounds to count being 5.
(iii) There will be a bonus of 10 points up to an annual maximum of 20 points for registered competitors who are named in the Regulations of a round and fulfil a named role during the event, and a bonus of 10 points for registered competitors who marshal on any rounds on which they do not compete. Points gained in this way will count towards the overall scores for named organisers and towards the class awards for marshals. These points are in addition to scores gained as a competitor.
(iv) Navigators and drivers registered for the challenge can score when teamed with any driver or navigator. Registered competitors can also score either as a navigator or driver and their scores will be allocated to the role fulfilled on the rounds entered.

7) Awards: subject to the number of registered competitors, overall and class awards will be presented at the end of the season to competitors who have competed on at least 3 rounds.
