Supplementary Regulations

- 1/ **Announcement** Wigton Motor Club will promote Club Sport Autosolo on Sunday 28th April 2024 at the Maryport Business Centre, Main Road, Maryport CA15 8NG immediately to the south of the West Coast Karting building.
- 2/ **Jurisdiction** The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
Motorsport UK permit number :
- 3/ **Eligibility** Competitors must be a member of Wigton Motor Club. Alternatively, Spadeadam MC, Eden Valley MC, West Cumbria MS Club, South of Scotland CC, Kirkby Lonsdale MC & Hexham & DMC are also invited to enter.
All competitors (Drivers and Navigator/Passenger) must be in possession of a Motorsport UK RS Clubman licence as a minimum. Available free from - <https://www.motorsportuk.org/get-started/2020-rs-clubman-licence/>
- 4/ **Championship** The event is a qualifying round of the WMC club championships.
- 5/ **Programme** Will be as follows:

Arrival	from 10.00
First test	from 10.30
Estimated finish	15.00
- 6/ **Classes** There will be 4 classes at the event
 - F) FWD
 - R) RWD
 - C) Pre 1984
 - J) Junior (under 17 years)

The minimum for a class is 3. The maximum for the event is 20 and the minimum will be 10. Should the minimum figure not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the meeting.
All vehicles must be driven into the venue and be taxed, insured and have a valid MOT if applicable, the responsibility for this lies with the entrant. A passenger is allowed but must be aged 12 years or over. Cars with no hood/hardtop fitted passenger must be 16 years or over. Seat belts must be worn and road tyres only for all vehicles.
- 7/ **Junior entries** – Autosolo entries may be accepted from drivers who are 14 years or over who do not hold a full RTA licence subject to the following: The vehicle must in definition be a ‘touring car’, engine capacity must not exceed 2000cc including forced induction. A passenger must be carried who holds a full RTA licence and has Autosolo experience.
- 8/ **Entry** The entry list opens with the publication of these regulations and **closes five days before the event. 23/04/24**
Entries must be made on the attached form and emailed or sent via WhatsApp to the organiser. Entry will be confirmed once payment has been received. **Entries will not be accepted by phone, social media or on the day. The entry fee is £25.**

- 9/ **Times/Penalties** Timing will be to the nearest whole second. All protests must be made in accordance with the Motorsport UK yearbook, section C.
- a) Failure to attempt a test 20 secs plus the fastest within the class
 - b) Wrong test * 20 secs plus the fastest within the class
 - c) Striking a cone or marker 5 secs for each occurrence
 - d) Failure to stop astride any line 10 secs for each occurrence including the finish line
 - e) Jump start 10 secs
- * If the driver returns to the point of their mistake, and then completes the test correctly, there is no penalty.

Times will be recorded on the marshal's sheet, he/she will convey the time of each test to the driver who may record it him/herself on the form provided.

- 10/ **Tests.** There will be one large test area, run at least three times with all scores being taken into account for the total time. This may vary according to competitor numbers, weather etc.
Tests are marked with cones which may be less than 1 metre in height. There will be no reversing or 360 manoeuvres.
