



Grass Autotest and Production Car Taster Autotest

Sunday 19th July 2026 at Branthwaite, Workington

Supplementary Regulations

- 1/ **Announcement** Wigton Motor Club will promote Club Sport Autotest and Production Car Autotest on Sunday 19th July 2026 at Brow Top Farm, Branthwaite, Workington, CA14 4TG. The event is on level grass fields.
- 2/ **Jurisdiction** The meeting will be held under the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
Motorsport UK permit numbers - TBA
- 3/ **Eligibility** This is a Taster event and it is not necessary to be a club member..

All competitors (Drivers and Navigator/Passenger) must be in possession of a Motorsport UK RS Clubman licence as a minimum. Available free from - <https://www.motorsportuk.org/competitors/rs-clubman-licence/>

A passenger is not permitted in an Autotest. A passenger is mandatory in a PCA and must be aged 12 years or over and at least 135cm in height. Cars with no hood/hardtop fitted, passenger must be 16 years or over. Seat belts must be worn and **road tyres only** for all vehicles.

- 4/ **Championship** The event is a qualifying round of the WMC club championship.

- 5/ **Programme** Will be as follows:

Arrival	from 09.30
First test	from 10.30
Estimated finish	15.30

- 6/ **Classes** There will be 4 classes at the event.

F)	FWD AT	FP)	FWD PCA
R)	RWD AT	RP)	RWD PCA

The minimum for a class is 3. The maximum for the event is 30 and the minimum will be 8. Should the minimum figure not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the meeting.

- 7/ **Junior entries** – Autotest entries may be accepted from drivers who are 15 years or over and are at least 135cm in height who do not hold a full RTA licence subject to the following: The vehicle must in definition be a ‘touring car’, up to 1400cc, forced induction is not permitted.
PCA entries may be accepted from drivers who are 13 years or over and are at least 135cm in height who do not hold a RTA licence subject to the following. The vehicle must by definition be a ‘touring car’ up to 2000cc including forced induction. A passenger must be carried who holds a full RTA licence and Autotest/Autosolo experience.

- 8/ **Entry** The entry list opens with the publication of these regulations. Entries must be made on the attached form or online form (if available) and sent to the organiser. Entries will not be accepted by phone or social media. The entry fee is **£30**. Any entrant under 18 years will pay no fee.
- 9/ **Times/Penalties** Timing will be to the nearest whole second. All protests must be made in accordance with NCR Chapter 2 Appendix 9.

| a) Failure to attempt a test | 20 secs plus the fastest within the class |
| b) Wrong test * | 20 secs plus the fastest within the class |
| c) Striking a cone or marker | 5 secs for each occurrence |
| d) Failure to stop astride any line | 5 secs for each occurrence including the finish line |
| e) Jump start | 5 secs |
- * If the driver returns to the point of their mistake, and then completes the test correctly, there is no penalty. In every other case the time taken will be the time recorded.
- Drivers will be identified by name and/or number. Timing will be by marshals stop watch using a countdown. Timing will stop when the leading wheel of the front axle crosses the line of the stop astride/finish line. Times will be recorded on the marshals sheet, he/she will convey the time of each test to the driver.
- 10/ **Tests** There will be various test areas, each run at least three times with all scores being taken into account for the total time. This may vary according to competitor numbers, weather etc. Diagrams will be made available on the day. Tests are marked with cones which may be less than 1 metre in height.
- 11/ **Noise** Ensure compliance of NCR Chapter 7 Appendix 13 'C' ie. 88db at 2m distance at 4500rpm. Specifically relating to the Maryport site – testing will be carried out to confirm and any entrant not able to comply will be unable to start the event.
